



## HOW YOU CAN “FIND-A-BOOK” FOR YOUR STUDENT THIS SUMMER

The “Find-A-Book” Web site – [www.lexile.com/findabook](http://www.lexile.com/findabook) – is a fun and easy way to find books at a student’s Lexile (reading) level. Students can use this free online tool to build custom reading lists of books on the subjects that interest them. Just follow these five simple steps:

1. **GO TO** [www.lexile.com/findabook](http://www.lexile.com/findabook)
2. **ENTER** a Lexile measure  
*(This measure is found on the students’ Reading end-of-grade or English I test results)*
3. **PICK** interest categories
4. **VIEW/REFINE** search results
5. **PRINT** a custom summer reading list

A Lexile is a measure of a student’s reading ability. Lexiles do not address age-appropriateness, an individual’s interests, or text quality. The Lexile measure is a good starting point in picking a book. To find out more, visit [www.lexile.com](http://www.lexile.com).
